## Group Guitar Lesson Information Form

Thanks for your interest in this program. This program is **strictly** for children ages 9-14. Please note that certain sessions are only for certain ages though.

We're currently offering two beginning class sessions, and one advanced class session. Here are the dates for each:

\* Session JAN101 is January 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and February 4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> w/ optional January 7<sup>th</sup> orientation.) Each JAN101 class is on a Wednesday from 5-6pm in the Children's Department of the Main Library. This session is only for children ages 9-11.

\* Session MAR101 is March 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, and April 1<sup>st</sup> w/ optional Feb 25<sup>th</sup> orientation.) Each MAR101 class is on a Wednesday from 5-6pm in the Children's Department of the Main Library. This session is only for children ages 12-14.

\* Advanced Session DEC202 is available Tuesday Dec 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. This session consists of three classes. They are available only to students completing either a 101 session or passing a proficiency interview. Proficiency interviews are held between 10-4pm on Nov 7<sup>th</sup> and Nov 8<sup>th</sup>. Come with your guitar on these days to meet with Mr. Josh. Each DEC202 class is on a Tuesday from 3:30-4:30 in the Children's Department of the Main Library. This session is for children ages 9-14.

Students may currently only register for one session. Each session is limited to 10 students and work on a first come, first serve, basis. You'll be notified via phone if you are in the session you choose. **Students are expected to attend every class in the session**, as the learning process is cumulative. Again, **do not** sign up if your child can't make it to every class in the session.

Ownership of a guitar is not mandatory for the class, but **highly** recommended for practicing purposes.

The optional orientation classes are for the students of that session to meet the instructor, bring in their guitar (or see the few available for classroom use) and to talk about each student's interest in music.
